Recreation Age Extension

We will be extending the age groups for our Recreation level for the Fall Season. We will be introducing a 10-13 yr old division for any current or new player interested in playing soccer, but not at the travel level. Existing travel players will also be able to sign up for the Recreation league by paying just the uniform fee of \$20 prior to the start of the season. Games will be held on Thursday or Friday nights. If you are interested in coaching, please contact us through our website. Registration for the new age group will be conducted on May 19 and 27th from 6 - 9 PM at the Middle School.

2009-10 Registration

Registration for the Fall 2009 - Spring 2010 season will be handled differently this year. Travel team players will be able to register directly with their respective coach. Recreation and New players will have 2 dates to choose from. Players interested in trying out for a Fall Travel team will need to register on either May 19 or May 27th, between 6 - 9 pm at the Middle School. Players registering for Recreation only can also register on June 6th during your regularly scheduled games. A separate Registration flyer containing tryout details is posted on our website.
